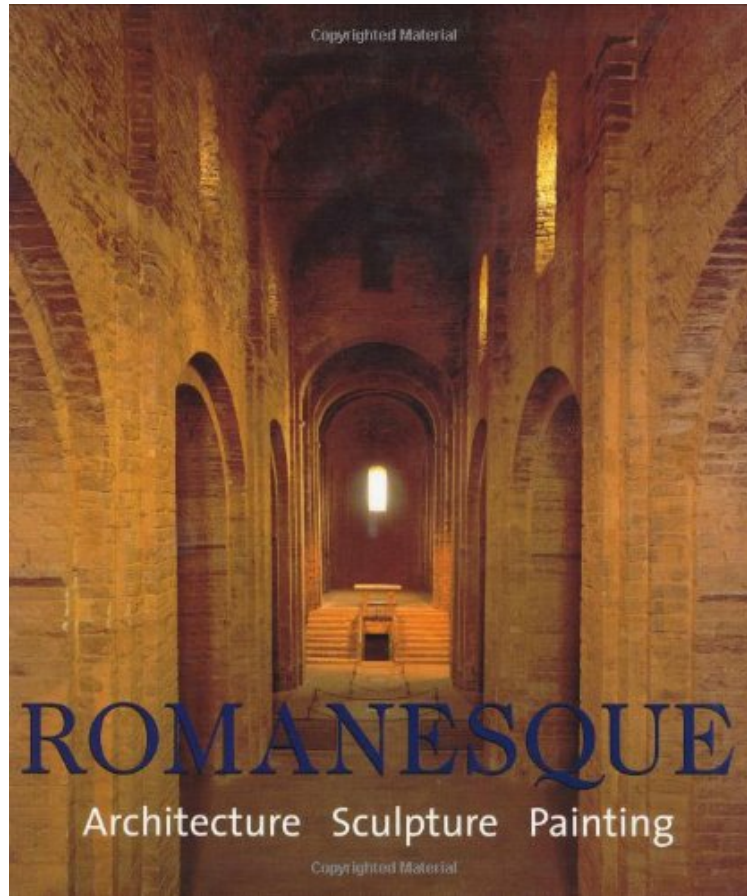

It is a beautifully stitched book in hardcover form with an attractive dustcover. I like this book because of its size 9" x 10.5" and its glossy pages filled, nay, jam-packed with colour plates of examples from Christian and secular architecture. The geographical scope of this quite conservative architectural style is wide from southern Spain to northern Scandinavia ; indeed we are told that it was the first architectural style that covered the whole of Europe. Renaissance commentators called this the dark ages but you wouldn't think so looking at these wall paintings and column sculptures. I purchased the hard cover version of this 2004 edition which provides quite exceptional value for the student of architecture or student of early medieval Europe (without the kings and queens).
