An ideal size (with week-to-view pages), on one side are the days and on the other beautiful pictures of flowers and fruit with full details of the plants including their scientific names. This year all the illustrations are by women and the artistry is wonderful. The diary itself is hardcover with a robust, slightly glossy paper - fine for biros and ink pens; less good if, like me, you sometimes use a fountain pen. But this is only a minor quibble. There's also a page marker and a handy pocket at the front for storing scraps of paper etc. If you haven't got yourself a diary for 2012 yet, I recommend this without

The RHS Diary 2018 brings together a beautiful collection of wildflower illustrations, showcasing work held in the RHS's world-famous Lindley Library. Artists featured include Margaret Mary Plues (1828-1901), Lydia Penrose (1787-1842), Lilian Snelling (1879-1972) and Maria Morris, whose work dates from the 1800s. This week-to-view diary is illustrated in colour throughout and has a ribbon marker.
