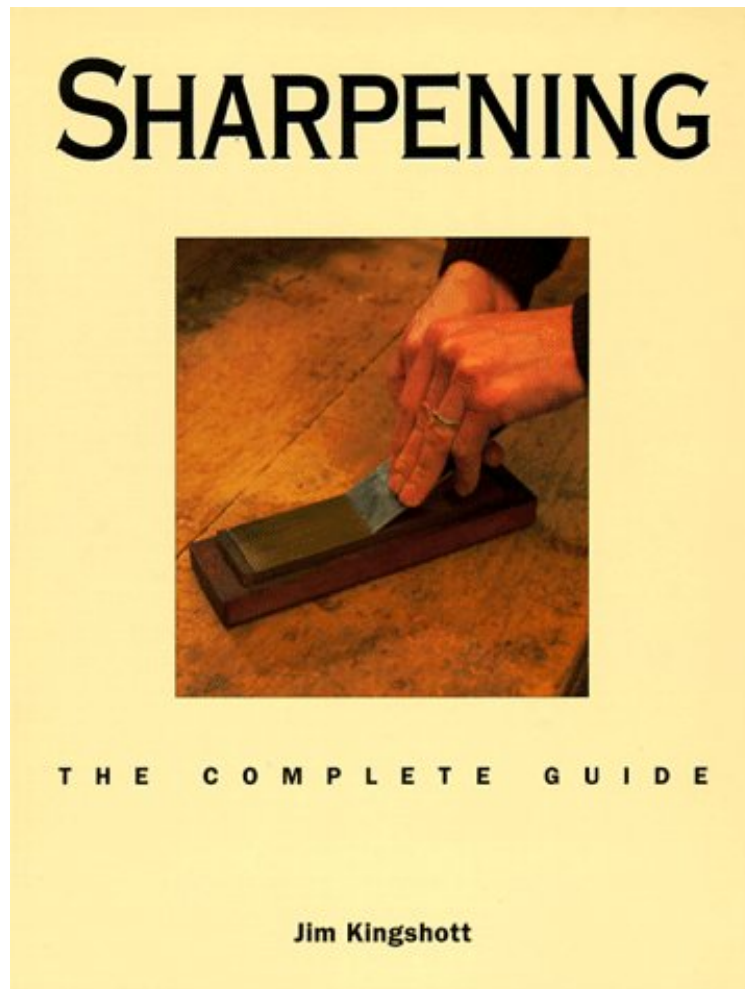

The author, a professional cabinetmaker, has written a guide to a fundamental, often controversial, aspect of woodworking. It includes a thorough examination of the grindstone, how to use it, how to dress it, and what abrasives to use. The author then looks at honing, the range of stones on offer, maintenance, lubricants and the diamond sharpening systems.
