woodworking techniques for beginning woodworkers. A knowledge of woodworking is undoubtedly helpful, but not absolutely necessary, for anyone with access to the tools and a place to work. Some of the projects are basic ones you might expect to find: square and rectangular planters, a tool rack caddy, hanging shelves. But some are unexpected: a charming picket-fence bench, an elegant garden chair, an herb planter, a small Japanese arbor. And more. All in all, a fine book. My edition has a different cover--the picket-fence bench mentioned above, but the sundial shown on some covers is also in my book.

Like never before, people have the time to get the most out of their gardens, so that, more and more, they are becoming extensions of the home in which to entertain, relax and, of course, grow every type of plant using a plethora of planting techniques. With *Simple Handmade Garden Furniture* every garden can be given the personal touch, with items as diverse as an unusual table which incorporates a herb planter, a ladder frame decorated with hanging baskets of bulbs and a simple rustic rope-entwined trellis for honey-suckle or roses. All the projects can be completed in a weekend by the novice woodworker with the minimum of tools. Each is extensively explained with the help of clear step-by-step photography and all the most common techniques are covered in a separate Techniques section.
