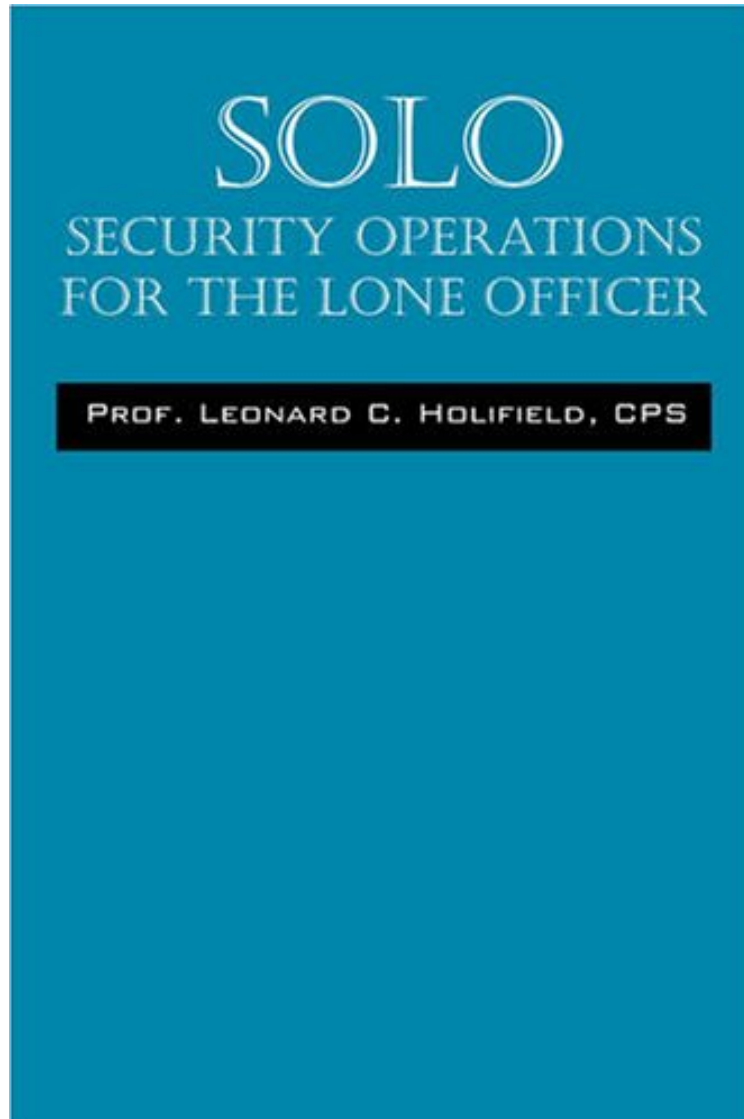

I found it to contain nothing more substantive than the author recounting basic skills and attributes which might apply to any protective professional; whether the lone protector or a member of a team, and a few of his personal recommendations in the area of conduct and equipment choices. The book did not describe any practices or

procedures that might be of real value to an individual working a single agent detail. The only part of the text I could readily concur with is the author's choice of Glock pistols as a recommended sidearm for protection professionals (I'm a Glock aficionado myself). Additionally, the author's advice to train with your client on emergency action drills and shooting is wholly unrealistic, as is his "spend off duty time with your client" outside of your working relationship. I totally disagree with this reasoning and really do not desire to cultivate a relationship any more than required with a protectee. A familiar relationship as he has described and advocates could well cloud an agent's judgment in emergency situations, and in no way do I want my protectee armed. All in all, this is a poorly written tome that repeatedly states the obvious and is of little to no value to a protective professional embarking on a single agent detail. I have worked a number of single agent details myself; both domestically and abroad, and found nothing here of value for conducting this type of operation. One's funds would be better spent on authors in the field such as Richard Aitch, Dale June, or Bob Oatman, who have a proven track record of relevant, engaging, and authoritative commentary on protective security in all venues.
