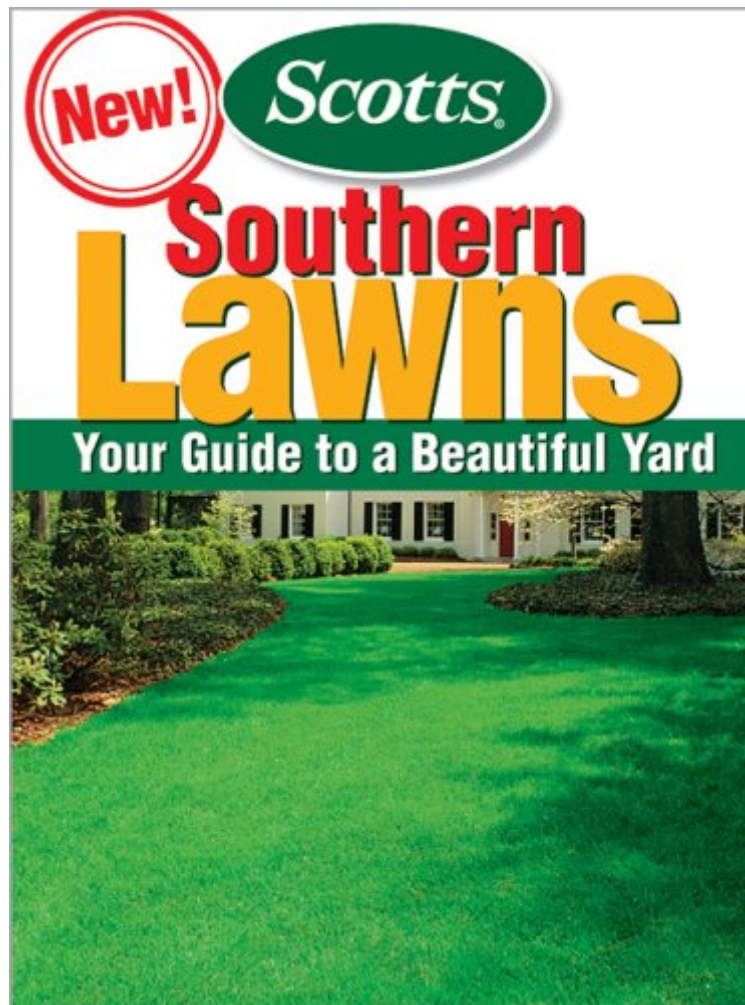

For me, the reasons for having a lawn service are threefold: 1), preventing bugs from destroying your yard and

requiring resodding - especially a problem in Florida, 2), preventing weeds from taking over your yard, 3), making your lawn look as good as it can, recognizing that I don't have a million dollar estate. If you want every blade of grass to be perfect, NASA could probably do it, but at a cost of a million dollars a treatment. Now that we're retired, I was thinking that I would have more time to take care of my lawn by myself, saving some of the \$600 a year that I pay my lawn service.
