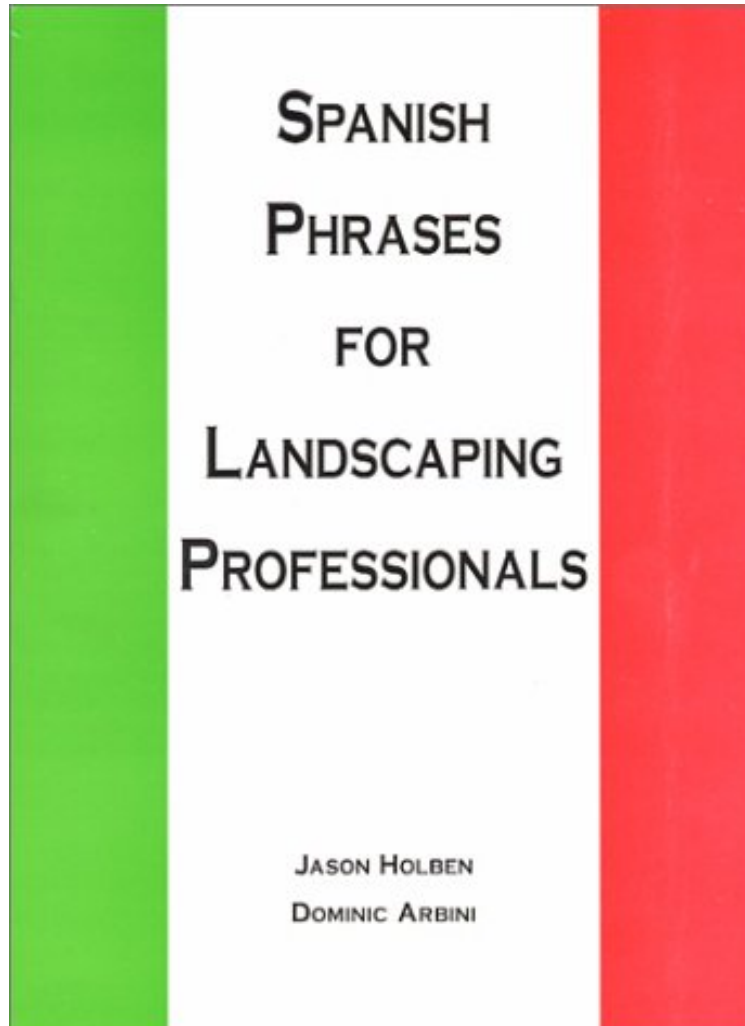

It also has a very useful vocabulary list in the back. It won't take the place of a series of night classes at the local technical college, but it will get you through the work week.If you already speak a little spanish, this is a 5 star book.Downsides? There are some typos (misplaced or missing accent marks, wrong gender for noun) that will make the some-spanish speakers a little crazy, and make the non-spanish speakers look like fools to their hispanic workers.Still, I take this book to

It is not a good fit for regular homeowners dealing with a landscaper/gardner. This book will help in giving complex instructions (how to put fuel into lawnmowers, how long the workday will be, how not to get injured, how to install a sprinkler system). It will not help with asking the lawn to be mowed or checking an individual sprinkler head or cutting back growth or all the small things a homeowner usually has done around the yard.2 of 5 people found the following review helpful. FigueroaIt is apparent as I reference this manual that the direct limitation is in how limited the phrases are as it applies to usage in settings other than the landscape industry. Granted, there are other useful phrases that have enabled me to communicate better than I have prior to owning this manual. However, the gap present, and, by no fault of the authors, is one that does not present language that allows me to effectively direct in the nursery/greenhouse environment. Regardless, Holben Arbini are to be commended for taking that all too important first step in assisting those of us deficient in the language arts. I'm pleased with the purchase. It supports me greatly in it's own way.

"Spanish Phrases For Landscaping Professionals" is a collection of user-friendly words and phrases to help English speaking Managers and Crew leaders communicate with their Hispanic employees. It covers hiring and training, safety, equipment use and maintenance, demolition, prep., installation, light masonry, grounds maintenance...etc. There is also a section for dealing with injuries. This book is NOT a textbook, but rather a "point and shoot" phrase book for Landscapers who need to say it NOW, and who have not found time to learn Spanish while working 60 hour weeks.
