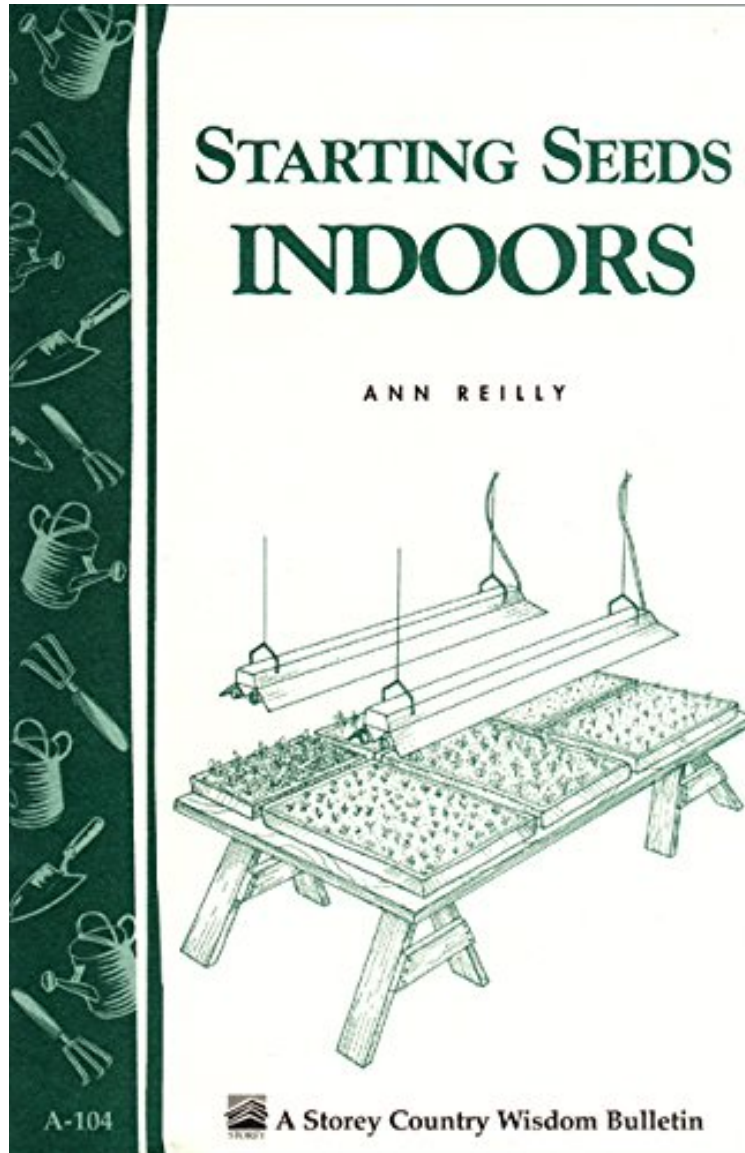

I'm by no means a chemical-phobe, but it would seem to me that good cleanliness/sanitation practices, not unlike those in home brewing, would be enough to prevent disease, especially if one is using sterile medium and cleaning their containers well enough. Does anyone know whether use of something like benomyl fungicide would be considered organic or not?
