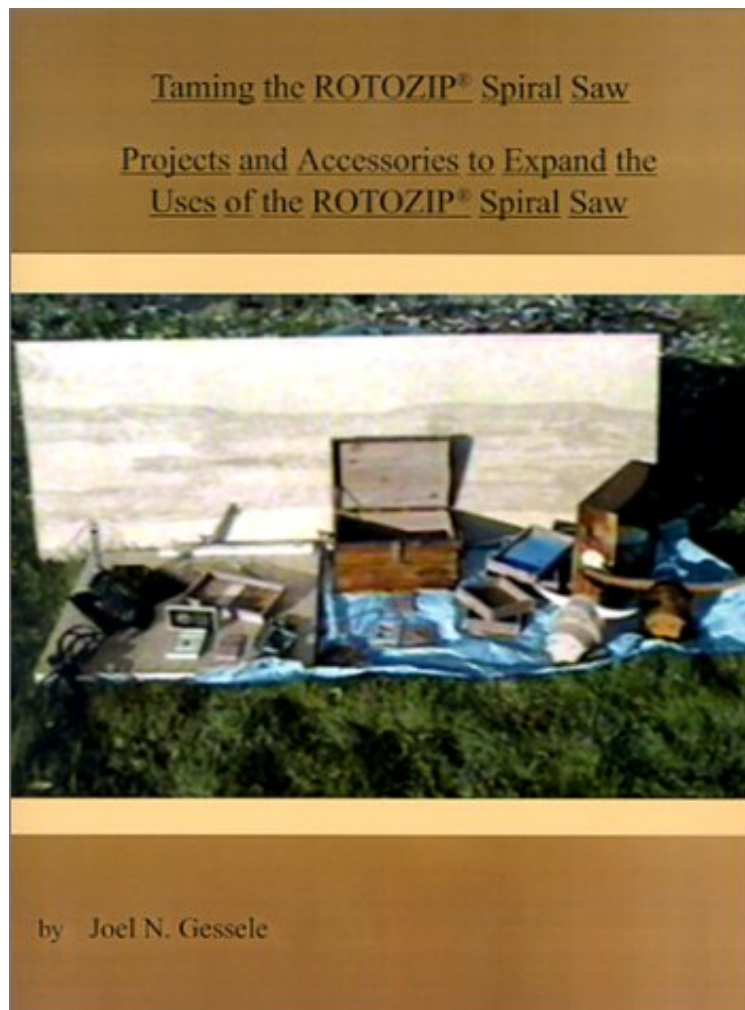

The author presents only two accessories: a base plate and a work table top. Unfortunately, their construction is described in an appendix rather than

before the description of the projects in which they are used. The projects themselves are of marginal utility. The book suffers from poor production values, the copious pictures being so poor in focus and contrast as to detract from their content. Although the author rightly emphasizes the safety issues inherent in the use of the Rotozip, none of the pictures show the use of appropriate fences or guards.
