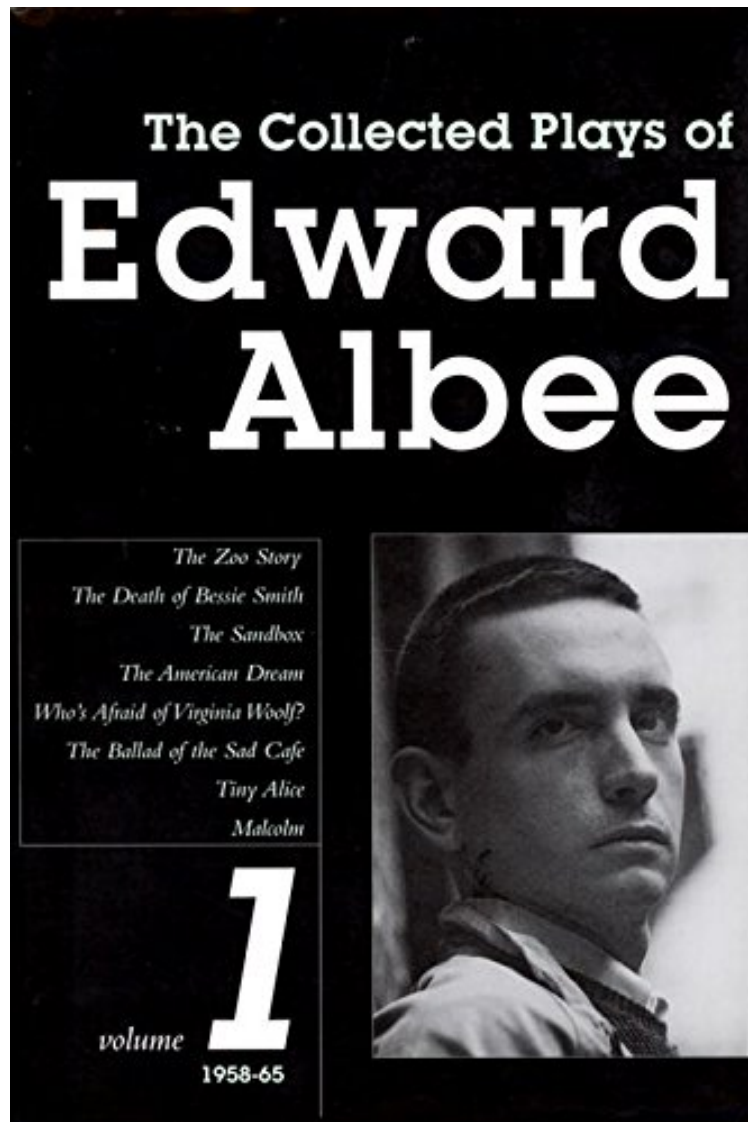

The first volume of this three-volume collection contains the eight plays written by Albee during his early years as a playwright, from 1958 through 1965. These range from the four brilliant one-act plays with which he exploded on the New York theater scene *The Zoo Story*, *The Death of Bessie Smith*, *The Sandbox*, and *The American Dream* to his early masterpiece, *Who's Afraid of Virginia Woolf?* Also included are two adaptations from notable American novels *The Ballad of the Sad Caf* and *Malcolm* and Albee's mysteriously fascinating *Tiny Alice*. This book represents one of the most exciting and bold periods in the career of one of America's most popular and imaginative playwrights.

About the Author Edward Albee (1928-2016), his plays include *The Zoo Story* (1958), *The American Dream* (1960), *Who's Afraid of Virginia Woolf?* (1961, Tony Award), *Tiny Alice* (1964), *A Delicate Balance* (1966, Pulitzer Prize, and Tony Award, 1996), *Seascape* (1974, Pulitzer Prize, also available from Overlook), *Three Tall Women* (1994, Pulitzer Prize), and *The Play About the Baby* (2001, also available from Overlook). He was awarded the Gold Medal in Drama from the American Academy and Institute of Arts and Letters in 1980, and in 1996 he received both the Kennedy Center Honors and the National Medal of Arts.
